THE DEFENSE OF INSANITY AT THE TIME OF THE ACT IN CRIMINAL CASES IN IOWA

I. Theory of Defense of Insanity

Many lessons have been learned from the last war that have an application to the affairs of peace. Among these is the determination of the type of insanity which will be regarded as a defense to the commission of a crime. In army court-martial cases the modern view has been accepted. Going beyond the test of right
