NOTES

THE COLLEGE OF LAW

The sixty-second year of the College of Law began on September 16, 1926. The registration for the first semester of 1926-27 is shown below in comparison with the final attendance figures for three preceding years:

Further registration the second semester will add somewhat to the total for the current year.

The class of 1926 numbered fifty-two, of whom thirty-nine received the Bachelor of Laws degree and thirteen received the Juris Doctor degree. Three members of the class received their degrees in February, thirty-nine received their degrees in June, four received their degrees in July, and six at the August convocation.

Clarence Milton Updegraff, a graduate of the College of Law of the class of 1916, has been appointed Professor of Law to succeed Malcolm Pitman Sharp who resigned as Assistant Professor of Law in June, 1926. Mr. Sharp now holds an appointment as Research
